	LITURGICAL MINISTRIES (St Agnes' Catholic Parish churches and chapeis)
	ALTAR SERVER (Children and youth aged 10-18 years assist the clergy with Masses and special occasion liturgies)
	COMMENTATOR (Introduce the Liturgy, pray the Intercessions, and lead the people in the prayers of the Mass)
	COMMUNION TO PARISHIONERS IN THE HOME or HOSPITAL (Appointed and commissioned as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion by the Parish Priest to take Holy Communion to those unable to attend Mass.
	EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER OF HOLY COMMUNION (Appointed and commissioned by the Parish Priest to assist with the distribution of Holy Communion at Masses.
	LEADER OF THE LITURGY OF THE WORD WITH HOLY COMMUNION (On occasions when the priests are unavailable to celebrate Mass, a Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion can be celebrated. Usually on weekdays with the view to implementing on Sundays if the need arises, formation and training is offered)
	LITURGY of the WORD for CHILDREN (Assist with special sessions for children during the 9.00am and 5.00pm Sunday Masses)
	MINISTER of the WORD (Reader) (Proclaim the Word, usually at Mass but also in other liturgical rites. Formation and training is offered)
	SACRISTAN (Assist with preparing the church/chapel for Mass and serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion when required)
	SACRAMENTAL MINISTRIES
	BAPTISM PREPARATION TEAM (Assist with preparing families for the baptism of their child)
	SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM FOR OTHER SCHOOLS (Prepare children/youth for Confirmation, Reconciliation and First
	Holy Communion)
	JOURNEY INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH for ADULTS (18 years+) inc. RCIA (Accompany and support participants preparing for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults – RCIA)
Ш	JOURNEY INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH for TEENS (13-18 years) (Accompany and support participants preparing for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Youth and those wanting to learn more about the Catholic faith)
	MUSIC, MEDIA and ENVIRONMENT MINISTRIES
	MUSIC MINISTRY (Provide music as a musician or singer for Masses, liturgies, weddings, and funerals in the parish to assist people to engage in worship)
	AUDIO MIXER OPERATOR (Operate a digital audio mixer to ensure people can hear what's happening in our liturgies)
	MEDIA OPERATOR (Operate visual aids to help people engage in worship and stay informed about what's happening in the community)
	LIVESTREAM OPERATOR (Operate cameras and the livestream desk so people can engage in the liturgical life of the parish from home).
	ENVIRONMENT MINISTRY (Assist with areas such as floral arrangement, cleaning, and decoration of the Church)
	YOUTH MINISTRY
	ENCOUNTER YOUTH (Role 1 Youth Leader (17-30 years) - Accompany young people with games, personal sharing and roles working directly with young people) (Role 2 - Help with some of the behind-the-scenes roles such as cooking, serving food, cleaning, and car park ministry to parents)
	ENCOUNTER YOUNG ADULTS (Help lead the fellowship and formation of our Young Adults community. This would involve preparing discussions, leading small groups, organising fellowship dinners, and other initiatives created).

	GREETERS / WELCOMERS (Welcome people at weekend Masses, hand out bulletins, assist with seating, give directions as needed, and connect with new parishioners)
	CATERING COORDINATORS (Assist with organisation and serving of parish morning teas / suppers, funeral receptions, and parish activities)
	WARDENS (Organise money collections, oversee church accessibility, and support needs of the congregation)
Ħ	CARE AND CONCERN GROUP (Contact bereaved families and relatives)
	CHRISTMAS HAMPER GROUP (Prepare hampers for distribution to needy families / people at Christmas)
	AGED CARE
