



SACRAMENTAL MINISTRIES

R.C.I.A. (RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS)

DESCRIPTION: This process of Christian formation is offered to those who are seeking to become Catholic. The initiation of new members is a gradual process allowing enquirers time to grow in faith and become full participants of the Catholic community. The catechumenal journey or RCIA process is marked by three major liturgical rites that act as key gateways along the way and reaches its high point at the Easter Vigil ceremony. The RCIA is incorporated into the Journey into the Catholic Faith program.


