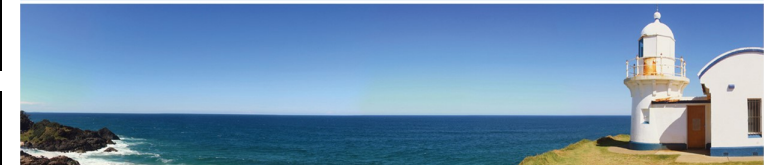

The Emmaus Aged Care Community provides a high level of care and accommodation for 116 residents.

Accommodation consists of single rooms with shared or private ensuite.

Emmaus has embraced a household model of care, the household model is characterised by:

A sense of home, a sense of belonging, enabling, engaging with life where the boundaries of the resident and his or her home are clear and respected as a matter of course. Groups of twelve to eighteen residents live in the eight Emmaus houses (Donnelly Place, Newman Place, Lourdes Place, Paul's Place, Joseph Place, Peter's Place, MacKillop and Agnes Place) actively sharing a kitchen, dining room and small intimate living areas supported by permanently assigned staff with all the skills and knowledge required to meet the residents needs.

Each household is a part of a neighbourhood of houses, dedicated to continuous growth. Building community with one another, our family, our neighbours, and our town.
