COURSE CONTENT:

- Roles and responsibilities of the first aider
- Management of unconscious, breathing and non-breathing casualties using the DRSABCD action plan
- CPR including the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Management of a choking casualty
- Recognition and treatment of musculoskeletal injuries
- Recognition and management of medical conditions including chest pain, anaphylaxis, asthma, stroke and seizures
- Treatment of bites and stings including the use of pressure bandage and immobilisation technique

MODE OF DELIVERY:

This training program is delivered face-to-face.

ASSESSMENT METHOD:

To achieve competency in JHI's Provide First Aid course you will need to complete both written and practical assessments, which will be evaluated by a qualified Trainer/Assessor. Participants whom are unable to complete all of the Knowledge and Performance Criteria will be issued with a Statement of Attendance only and will not receive a Statement of Attainment.
